NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON SPECIAL CHILDREN
WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES

The Philippine Women's University (PWU), JASMS, Quezon City will hold a 2-day National Conference on Special Children with Developmental Disabilities on May 21-22, 2009 at Quezon City Sports Club, E. Rodriguez Avenue with the theme "Contemporary Special Education: Directing the Future".

The conference aims are to:

- a. share the best practices of the different SPED centers/institutions and to present the services offered by various SPED organizations;
- b. aid teachers/parents in diagnosing children with special needs and to introduce teaching strategies that will be helpful for SPED teachers;
- c. serve as venue for the presentation of researches on disability studies; and
- d. strengthen professional collaboration among SPED centers/institutions.

The participants are the SPED teachers, students, administrators, parents and others.
